
Watering Guide

Our Watering Guide is based on Lowcountry temperature and whether you have well draining soil or poor draining soil.

If you live in North Mt. Pleasant (in <u>Dunes West</u>, <u>Park West</u>, <u>Carolina Park</u>, <u>Planter's Point</u>, <u>or others</u>), your soil tends to be poor draining clay soil. Your waterings will need to be thorough but not as frequent as if you have well-draining soil.

If you live in an area like the <u>Old Village, Cooper Estates, Ion, West Ashley, or downtown Charleston</u>, with well-draining topsoil, your plant will need, initially, a lot of water and frequently.

We recommend thoroughly and individually watering your plants with a hose directly onto the rootball as shown in the image below. New plants need a lot of water from the hose onto the rootball. This is especially true during our hot summer months, and it is *critical* to their success.
